Presenters are encouraged to contribute to the cadre of knowledge and experience through both oral presentations, demonstrations, or hands-on exercises. Each speaker should be prepared to speak for approximately 15 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for questions. Proposals for longer format activities or other creative ideas are welcome.

The deadline for a 200-word abstract and a short biographical sketch is **07 September, 2018**, and should be submitted electronically to **Justin Reed**. Abstracts should include general contact information – email address and telephone number – and identify the corresponding topic area. Papers will be accepted based on review by the Technical Program Committee.

Authors will be notified of acceptance by **14 September 2018**.
